Who Are We

FaithCare Outreach is a Woodburn, Kentucky-based medical missions organization established in May 2025. We don't just provide healthcare; we provide a bridge to the Savior. By partnering with local churches and missionaries around the world, we ensure that every physical treatment is accompanied by the spiritual healing found only in Jesus Christ. Each patient that comes through our clinics will hear the beautiful message of the gospel, presented in their own heart language by a volunteer from that local church.

To ensure the sustainability of these efforts, all of our clinics operate in conjunction with a local church. Our focus is to not only introduce hurting people to the Savior, but also provide them a connection to a church where they can find loving, compassionate encouragement for the challenge they will face in years to come. Our ministry is built on the belief that Jesus is the Great Physician.



What We Offer

We assemble and mobilize teams of medical professionals backed by non-medical volunteers to share the love of Christ using the tool of medicine.

- **Optical Clinics:** Providing eye exams, testing, and glasses through strategic partnerships with organizations like Global Vision 2020 and Lions Club.
- **Medical & Dental Care:** Addressing immediate physical ailments and pain through professional clinical support.
- **Spiritual Care:** Every patient hears the Gospel. We provide prayer, biblical counseling, and direct connection to local church plants for continued growth.
- **Strategic Leadership:** We equip churches and volunteers with sustainable, biblically-based outreach strategies to create lasting community impact.



Our precious patients are offered the spiritual support they need for themselves and their families through a door that was opened when someone cared enough to treat their pain. Long after our teams leave the field, many of these relationships continue when our former patients find a church home where they can grow and thrive in the company of people that love them.



A Typical Day on Mission

While every location—from the mountains of the Philippines to the regions of Honduras—presents unique challenges, a day with FaithCare Outreach is defined by purpose:

1. **Preparation & Prayer:** The team begins the day seeking God's guidance for the divine appointments ahead.
2. **The Clinic Rush:** Hundreds of locals often wait hours, sometimes walking through difficult terrain, to reach us. Our team manages intake, optical testing, and medical consultations.
3. **The "Great Physician" Connection:** As a person receives their first pair of glasses or medical treatment, a team member or local pastor shares the Gospel.
4. **Church Integration:** We to ensure every patient is invited into a local church family.
5. **Evening Reflection:** The team gathers to share stories of "professions of faith"—which numbered over 500 in our first year alone—and prepares for the next village.
